ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE ANGUS COUNCIL (LUNAN BAY, ARBROATH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2020

Angus Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf being satisfied that traffic on the road or roads referred to in this Order should be restricted or prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public on or near the said road or roads, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the "The Angus Council (Lunan Bay, Arbroath) (Temporary Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2020" and shall come into force from 18 July 2020 from which date it is anticipated that the prohibition of waiting will last for a period of 18 months, for the purpose of relieving congestion and maintaining free traffic flow.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 hereof, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in or on:
 - **Newton to Lunan to Montrose (C45)**

Both sides thereof; from a point 230 metres or thereby south of its junction with the access road to Lunan Bay Car Park in a northerly direction for a distance of 300 metres or thereby.
 - **Hawkhill Road (A92-C45)**

Both sides thereof; from its junction with the Newton to Lunan to Montrose road (C45) in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 50 metres or thereby.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to wait in the length of road specified in that Article if the vehicle is being used: -
 - (a) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer or drain or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus as defined in sub-paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (b) for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes or in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers and duties;
