ANGUS COUNCIL (OLD SHORE HEAD, ARBROATH) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2020

Angus Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1(1), 2(1), and 124(1) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (which Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Paragraph 20(1) of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the "Angus Council (Old Shore Head, Arbroath) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2020" and shall come into operation on the Thirty first day of August Two thousand and twenty.
- 2. The Order specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby varied and shall henceforth have effect subject to the amendments thereto specified and described in the said Schedule.

PART II PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES EXCEPT FOR LOADING ETC.

- 1. Between 3. MARKET PLACE and 4. SHORE insert the following:-
 - 4. OLD SHORE HEAD from a point 20 metres or thereby southeast of its junction with Marketgate generally southwards and southwestwards for a distance of 36 metres or thereby.
- 2. **4**. **SHORE** is renumbered as **5**.
