
Asset Transfer of AstroTurf Pitch at the Arbroath Sports Centre to Skilz Academy

Over the past year the Arbroath area has encountered a large volume of youth related calls. Throughout 2018 and into 2019 a considerable amount of work has been carried out by the local Officers to prevent and deter both Anti-Social Behaviour and Youths Causing Annoyance incidents. This has included, working with partners, pro-active patrols and engagement with the youths themselves.

As an organisation we are always looking for diversionary opportunities for our local youths and this is why we are very interested in the news that there is hopefully an opportunity for Skilz Academy to gain access to a local outdoor all weather pitch.

Throughout Angus, the Police are working closely with the whole community to improve the quality of life for the benefit of everyone living in your neighbourhood.

From time to time, young people, particularly when gathered together in groups, can behave in a manner that is out of character so as not to 'lose face'. This can result in rowdy behaviour, vandalism and underage drinking. Whilst many young people may not set out to cause problems, when gathered in large groups this can be intimidating and the noise they generate can cause distress and fear to those living in the community.

Officers encourage our young people to attend local youth groups and to participate in organised and supervised group activities. Young people need

stimulated and this proposed multi-sport facility will without doubt be beneficial to a whole host of local groups in the community, having a positive effect on not only individual's physical wellbeing but also their mental health.

To whom it may concern,

I am the chairperson for Arbroath Community Sports club. I am writing to you concerning the application from Skilz Academy in relation to the proposed upgrade and rebuild of Arbroath sports centres all weather pitch.

What Skilz Academy are proposing all sounds very positive and as far as we are concerned can only be a positive to the community and local clubs who would benefit from its use. As it stands Arbroath is about the only town in Angus that does not have either a 3g or 4g pitch.

I have been part of ACSC since 2008 and facilitating winter training in the town has always been a problem. Most younger teams will go inside but for the older ones who play during the winter, outdoor training is a must, but for the last couple of years more and more coaches are now refusing to use the current one. This is mainly because it is unsafe. I have first-hand experience of watching boys train on it in damp conditions and seen them sliding and falling on it, which one evening resulted in a boy dislocating his knee. Sprinkling sand on what basically feels like thin carpet, to 'keep it safe' is not working. This facility is not fit for purpose as it stands. And as a sports club our main priority is providing a safe environment for children to train on and at the moment this facility does not provide that.

So after speaking to [REDACTED] and hearing what they are hoping to achieve, I can only see this as a positive for all of the community who will use it. The amount of sports clubs alone in the town who would find this facility beneficial is immense, and would probably be booked out most of the time well in advance.

I hope you will have serious consideration to Skilz Academy's application and Arbroath can have a reliable, safe facility to use.



We as a club play all our home matches at the high school and feel it is a safe environment for the club members, the addition of a 3G facility would be fantastic for our and many more clubs in the local area.

To whom it may concern,

As you may already be aware Skilz Academy are currently pursuing an asset transfer to take ownership of the astroturf pitch at Arbroath Sport Centre in order to replace it with a brand new 3G surface.

The current surface was installed in 2004 and is long overdue for replacement and is not used by the majority of the community and local sports clubs due to its state of repair rendering it unsafe and prone to flooding. Current usage figures are 3-5 hours per week for 8-9 months and zero for 3-4 months of the year with the only constant booking being for the athletics club.

By replacing the surface and upgrading the ancillary services Skilz will create a real community asset that Arbroath can be proud of.

Our plans for the new surface call for a user centred approach to our activities and this new venture will benefit from that approach by working with all individuals and groups within our community to best utilize this new facility. Whilst the main aim is to improve sporting facilities for those in our community the secondary benefits such as opportunity, health and aspiration are equally important to us.

Skilz Academy as a two-tier SCIO is capable of having both organisations and individuals as members and will seek to encourage as many people and organisations to take up membership. By working in this way, every member of our charity has the ability to decide how best to use the new facility to benefit our entire community.

Whilst Skilz Academy will be the custodians of the new facility it will truly be owned by the community.
