THE ANGUS COUNCIL (BLOOMFIELD PLACE - MUIRFIELD PLACE FOOTPATH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF ACCESS) ORDER 2020

Angus Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Footpath Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf being satisfied that traffic on the footpath or footpaths referred to in this Order should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said footpath or footpaths, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the "The Angus Council (Bloomfield Place - Muirfield Place Footpath) (Temporary Prohibition Of Access) Order 2020" and shall come into force from Monday 26 October 2020 from which date it is anticipated that the work will last for a period of 22 weeks, however, the maximum duration in terms of said Act is 18 months, for the purpose of carrying out carriageway and verge works.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 hereof, no person shall access the footpath between Bloomfield Place and Muirfield Place Arbroath for a distance of 50m or thereby.

The alternative route for pedestrian traffic is via Bloomfield Place, Arbirlot Road West, Muirfield Place. The reverse route applies.

3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any person to proceed in the length of footpath specified in that Article if the person is being used: -
  - (a) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of footpath, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of footpath, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of footpath, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of footpath of any sewer or drain or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus as defined in sub-paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (b) for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes or in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers and duties.
