THE ANGUS COUNCIL (LEVEL CROSSING, WELLGATE, ARBROATH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2020

Angus Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf being satisfied that traffic on the road or roads referred to in this Order should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said road or roads, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as "The Angus Council (Level Crossing, Wellgate, Arbroath) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2020" and shall come into force from 7 January 2021 from which date it is anticipated that the works will last for a period of 26 days, however, the maximum duration in terms of said Act is 18 months, for the purpose of the full renewal of track, ballast, and road panels over the level crossing.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 hereof, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to drive or be driven on Wellgate, Arbroath from its junction with Stobcross eastwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby.

Access for pedestrians and emergency vehicles will be maintained.

The alternative routes for vehicular traffic are via Stobcross/Cairnie Street/Lochlands Street/Spink Street/Robert Street or Stobcross/Guthrie Port/Burnside Drive/Hume Street/Orchard Street. The reverse routes apply.

West John Street will be for local access only and the diversion from West John street is via Catherine Street/A92 Burnside Drive/Guthrie Port/Stobcross

3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to drive or be driven in the length of road specified in that Article if the vehicle is being used: -
 - (a) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer or drain or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus as defined in sub-paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (b) for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes or in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers and duties;
