#### **LOCAL BUS SERVICE PROVISION – CONTRACTS RETENDER**

#### IAN COCHRANE, DIRECTOR OF INFRASTRUCTURE

#### **ABSTRACT**

This report seeks authority for the Director of Infrastructure to award nine local bus service contracts upon the conclusion, and best value analysis, of a tender process. Furthermore, the report details the decision of the Director of Infrastructure to extend six local bus service contracts to the end of financial year 2020/21.

#### 1. RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Committee:

- (i) notes the decision of the Director of Infrastructure to extend contracts A603, A605, A606, A607, A608 and A466 to the end of financial year 2020/21.
- (ii) notes the decision of the Director of Infrastructure to undertake a tender for the replacement local bus service contracts, A371, A372, A466, A496, A603, A605 A606, A607 and A608.
- (iii) authorise the Director of Infrastructure, in consultation with the Director of Legal and Democratic Services, to award the replacement local bus service contracts, A371, A372, A466, A496, A603, A605 A606, A607 and A608 upon the conclusion of a tender and best value analysis exercise.

# 2. ALIGNMENT TO THE ANGUS LOCAL OUTCOMES IMPROVEMENT PLAN/CORPORATE PLAN

This report contributes to the following local outcomes contained within the Council Plan 2019-2024 and Local Outcomes Improvement Plan 2017-2030:

- Angus is a great place to live, work and visit
- · Our communities are safe, secure, vibrant and sustainable
- Our carbon footprint is reduced
- We have an inclusive and sustainable economy

#### 3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 Local bus service contracts are normally awarded with a contract length of three years, with the ability for the contracts to be extended into years four and five, should both the Council and operator agree to the extension. Each of the noted contracts have now reached the end of their lifespan.
- 3.2 Local bus contracts A603, A605, A606, A607, A608 and A466 were due to be retendered in May 2020, at that time a start time for the new contracts in August 2020. As this was during the national lockdown in accordance with Report 121/20 the Director of Infrastructure was provided with delegated powers, where urgently required, to extend contract period for existing contracts without retendering where the tendering is not feasible.
- 3.3 The Director of Infrastructure extended these contracts until 4 April 2021 as tendering during the period of lockdown was not feasible. The extension was to allow for increased competition within the tender process, by providing time for the recovery of the local bus service industry after it had been negatively impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic.

- 3.4 It is noted that during the spring of 2020, Scotland was placed into a national lockdown, which vastly reduced the amount of travel. Importantly, people were advised by both the UK and Scottish Governments not to travel on public transport unless absolutely necessary. This resulted in a vast reduction of local bus service provision, causing many bus operators' staff, particularly those employed for the purposes of commercial management, including tendering, to be placed on furlough.
- 3.5 Furthermore, given the uncertainty during 2020 concerning job retention, companies long term viability and the future of public transport use, it was considered extension of existing contracts protected he council's interest to deliver local bus contracts in the short to medium term.
- 3.6 All contracts are considered to provide lifeline local bus services to the communities they serve, and details of the service provision is noted in **Appendix 1.**

#### 4. CURRENT POSITION

- 4.1 Local bus contracts A371, A372, A603, A605, A606, A607, A608 A466 and A469 have been advertised on Public Contracts Scotland and a tender exercise has been initiated with tenders returned on 15 January 2021.
- 4.2 The procurement of the required local bus services is via a single stage 'open' procedure. The first stage will be an assessment based on the European Single Procurement Document (ESPD) which addressed:
  - Pass/fail assessment against minimum requirements that the operator must hold a PSV Operator Licence issued by the Traffic Commissioner; and
  - Pass/fail assessment against minimum requirements that the operator must have or can commit to obtain, prior to the commencement of the contract, the levels of insurance cover indicated in the relevant Contract Notice.
- 4.3 Bids satisfying these criteria will be evaluated on the basis of the most economically advantageous tender (MEAT), whilst having regard to the following criteria which are weighted according to importance. Price is to be given a weighting of 90%, with the other quality criteria listed below given a total weighting of 10%. Once the tenders are evaluated, as noted below, then an acceptance will be issued to the tenderer providing the highest MEAT score within each Lot.

# **Quality Criterion**

- Maximisation of Passenger Benefit 5%: Tenderers to indicate additional quality provision in respect of the vehicles to be used over and above the minimum requirements of the contract through the provision of CCTV.
- Environmental Management 3%: Tenderers to identify what steps they intend to take over the life of the contract to reduce fuel use, lower carbon emissions and reduce pollution
- Fair Work Practices 2%: Tenderers to indicate how they commit to fair work practices for workers engaged in the delivery of the contract.

#### Price Criterion

• The weighted price of 90% will be evaluated on the basis of the lowest total price received in each Lot.

#### 5. PROPOSALS

5.1 It is proposed that replacement local bus contracts A371, A372, A466, A496, A603, A605, A606, A607 and A608, will initially commence operation on 5 April 2021 and operate until 26 May 2024, with the option to be extended on an annual basis for a further two years.

- 5.2 The renewal of contract A371 is proposed as this contract provides evening buses between Arbroath and Montrose. Whilst there is an alternative in Service X7 this is an express service which will not stop in most rural areas, does not serve Warddykes and is a coach service which causes accessibility issues.
- 5.3 The renewal of contract A372 is proposed as this contract provides Sunday buses between Arbroath and Montrose. Whilst there is an alternative in Service X7 this is an express service which will not stop in most rural areas, does not serve Warddykes and is a coach service which causes accessibility issues.
- 5.4 The renewal of contract A466 is proposed as this contract provides evening buses on Montrose town service. There are no other public transport options to Ferryden, Borrowfield, Hillside or Craigo.
- 5.5 The renewal of contract A496 is proposed as this contract provides daytime buses on Montrose town service. Whilst Service 47 operates in Montrose, there are no other public transport options to Links Health Centre and residential areas such as India Street, Traill Terrace and Glenesk Avenue.
- The renewal of contract A603 is proposed as this contract provides daytime buses on Montrose town service. Whilst service 52 also operates in Montrose, there are no other public transport options to outlying areas such as Ferryden, Hillside, Dubton and Craigo. Services 47A and 47B also transport entitled and non-entitled pupils to and from Montrose Academy on school days.
- 5.7 The renewal of contracts A605, A606, A607 and A608 are proposed as these contracts provide different elements of service 30, which operates between Brechin, Montrose, Edzell and also Stracathro Hospital. Service 30 is necessary to provide transport to and from employment, as well as access to shops, health care facilities and other local amenities. There are no alternative public transport options for these journeys.
- 5.8 The Committee are asked to authorise the Director of Infrastructure, in consultation with the Director of Legal and Democratic Services, to award the replacement local bus service contracts, A371, A372, A466, A496, A603, A605 A606, A607 and A608 upon the conclusion of the tender and best value analysis exercise.

#### 6. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

It is estimated the combined costs of all 9 contracts will be circa £250k per financial year and this will be updated in a future information report supplied to the Communities Committee.

The estimated costs for these contracts will be contained within the Infrastructure Services Tendered Services revenue budget for 2021/22 and future years.
