# **ROAD SAFETY FRAMEWORK TO 2030 UPDATE**

## REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF INFRASTRUCTURE

#### ABSTRACT

This report provides an update on the work of the Road Safety Member/Officer Working Group and seeks confirmation of the revised remit of the Road Safety Member/Officer Working Group.

## 1. **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Committee:

- agrees that the Road Safety Member/Officer Working Group in reviewing associated policies, plans and strategies shall include a review of Bus Transport, as detailed in this report;
- (ii) agrees that the Road Safety Member/Officer Working Group in reviewing associated policies, plans and strategies shall include a review of Winter Service, as detailed in this report; and
- (iii) notes the proposed Road Safety Member/Officer Working Group action plan for 2021/22.

#### 2. ALIGNMENT TO THE ANGUS COMMUNITY PLAN/COUNCIL PLAN

# 3. BACKGROUND

3.1 Reference is made to Article 5 of the minute of the Communities Committee on 28 May 2019, which approved the formation of a Member/Officer Working Group (MOWG) to inform the development of the new Road Safety Plan (Report No. 167/19). Further reference is made to Article 9 of the minute of the Communities Committee on 24 September 2019, which approved the revised remit of the Road Safety Member/Officer Working Group to review associated policies, plans and strategies (Report No. 321/19). Final reference is made to Article 6 of the minute of the Communities Committee on 24 November 2020, which approved the revised remit of the Road Safety Member/Officer Working Group to include Active and Sustainable Travel (Report No. 285/20).

- 3.2 The MOWG's primary role is 'to develop a new Road Safety Plan for Angus, which would take cognisance of the new national road casualty reduction targets and identify and prioritise action points to be taken forward to assist with achieving the reduction targets to 2030.
- 3.3 The report from Scottish Government on the consultation on Scotland's Road Safety Framework to 2030, which closed on 1 December 2020 is anticipated by the end of February 2021. This report is understood to include details of the Road Safety Delivery Plans, which will be required from each road authority, as well as details of new regional governance and funding arrangements for road safety actions to be included in the Delivery Plans.
- 3.4 A report on the consultation for revisions to The Highway Code, which closed on 27 October 2020 is also anticipated.

# 4. CURRENT POSITION

- 4.1 At the meeting of the Road Safety MOWG on 2 December 2020, a proposal was discussed to include Bus Transport within the remit of the MOWG given the close association with providing safe, affordable and sustainable travel in Angus.
- 4.2 At the meeting of the Communities Committee on 19 January 2021, a briefing for all elected members was agreed to provide an overview of Bus Transport in Angus. At the time of writing this report the briefing was being arranged
- 4.3 At the meeting of the Road Safety MOWG on 20 January 2021, a proposal to include a review of Bus Transport as an action of the MOWG was further discussed.
- 4.4 At the meeting of the Road Safety MOWG on 20 January 2021, a proposal to include a review of the Winter Service (reference Report No. 199/20) was discussed. This was considered particularly relevant during winter 20/21 when the demand for local footway treatment during COVID travel restrictions has been exceptional. It is also noted that the provision of active travel during winter should be considered in the Winter Service Policy.
- 4.5 A separate report on the Active Travel Strategy and Spaces for People interventions and pipeline of active travel projects, which fall under the remit of the Road Safety MOWG is presented to this Committee (reference Report No 43/21.).

#### 5. PROPOSALS

- 5.1 It is proposed that the committee agrees that the Road Safety Member/Officer Working Group in reviewing associated policies, plans and strategies shall include Bus Transport and Winter Service as detailed in the scopes included in Appendices 1 and 2 respectively. Details of the scopes and progress of the reviews of Bus Transport and Winter Service will be reported to future appropriate committees.
- 5.2 The reviews of Bus Transport and Winter Service, along with other priorities of the MOWG are shown in the proposed Road Safety Member/Officer Working Group action plan for 2021/22 in Appendix 1. Updates on the delivery and development of the action plan will be reported to future committees at key milestones and as approvals are required.

#### 6. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 6.1 There are no financial implications arising from this report.
- 6.2 There may be financial implications for the development of the delivery plans and actions from Scotland's Road Safety Framework to 2030, which will be reported to committee as required.
- 6.3 There may also financial implications from the reviews of Bus Transport and Winter Service, which will be reported to committee as required.
