THE ANGUS COUNCIL (FOOTPATH AT 62-64 HIGH STREET, ARBROATH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that on Monday, 08 March 2021, Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the footpath and because of the likelihood of danger to the public which is not attributable to such works.

The Order will come into force on Friday, 12 March 2021 from which date it is anticipated that the work will last for a period of 2 months. However, the maximum duration in terms of the Act is 18 months.

The Order prohibits passage for pedestrians on or along the footpath over its entire length between 62-64 High Street, Arbroath and the Marketgate/Ladybridge Street Public Car Park.

Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.

The alternative route for pedestrians is via High Street and Ladybridge Street.

The reverse route applies.
