

THE ANGUS COUNCIL (C30 MEMUS) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER
2021

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, 06 April 2021, Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, for the purpose of water mains replacement works.

The Order will come into force on Wednesday, 14 April 2021 from which date it is anticipated that the work will last for a period of 11 weeks. However, the maximum duration in terms of the Act is 18 months.

The Order prohibits all vehicular traffic from driving on the C30 Cortachy to Menmuir road from a point 400 metres or thereby south-east of its junction with the U401 Burnside of Inshewen Road (C30) at Cossacks, extending south-eastwards, southwards then eastwards to a point 450 metres or thereby north-east of its junction with U400 Memus Road (C31 - C30), a total distance of 2.5 kilometres or thereby. The public utility works will be undertaken in a phased manner with the prohibition of driving being effective on a rolling closure basis.

Access for pedestrians and emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

The alternative routes for vehicular traffic are via:

- C30 Cortachy to Menmuir / B955 Kirriemuir to Clova / C29 Forfar to Inverquharney / C31 Kirriemuir to Coull Smithy / U400 Memus Road (C31 - C30); or
- C30 Cortachy to Menmuir / U409 Baldoukie Road (C31 - C30) / C31 Kirriemuir to Coull Smithy / U400 Memus Road (C31 - C30).

The reverse routes apply.
