**Minutes of Meeting held 12 May 2021**

<p><b>Present:</b> Christine Russell, Tony Smith, Helen Robertson, Davie McArthur</p> <p><b>In attendance:</b> Cllr Duff</p> <p><b>Apologies:</b> Gill Stranock</p> <p>Helen Robertson welcomed everyone to the meeting.</p>	
<p><b>Minute of 10 April 2021, proposed Helen Robertson, seconded Tony Smith.</b></p> <p><b>Matters arising</b></p> <p><b>Caravans, Kinnaber Road, Hillside</b> No movement at the moment because of the COVID situation.</p> <p><b>Flooding on Main Road, Hillside (+ Craigo)</b> Action awaited. Situation still the same. Because of the recent rainfall water was pouring out from the bottom of the park onto the sleeping policeman and flowing down the Main Road.</p> <p>Davie stated there was also flooding at Craigo because the drains can't cope.</p> <p><b>Cycle route from Marykirk to Montrose</b> Cllr Duff said hopefully it won't be long before he is able to meet the Access person on site.</p> <p><b>Dubton car park</b> The Parks Manager is hoping to get work started in erecting low-level wood barriers on the site. Cllr Duff said residents are being laxed and parking where they shouldn't</p> <p><b>20 mph zones within Hillside</b> This is an 18-month trial over all the small villages within Angus.</p> <p><b>40 mph zone sign at Dubton</b> Cllr Duff said it has been agreed that the 40 mph zone will be extended to include the two cottages at Limekilns.</p> <p><b>Speeding on the Craigo straight</b> Cllr Duff said he had a meeting with the police who accept there is an issue of people speeding and they will do some enforcement.</p> <p><b>Borrowfield – Hillside via Borrowfield Farm road</b> Cllr Duff said he is meeting with someone from Access on site tomorrow to look at the pond which has accumulated under the railway bridge in Borrowfield.</p>	
<p><b>Planning (email from Tony 11 May 2021)</b> Two relevant applications:</p>	

<p>1. 21/00309 - 1 Dalgarno Park, Hillside – extension to existing house.  2. 21/00317 – The Paddock, Lamondfauld Road, Hillside – extension to existing house.</p> <p>Both these applications are in private gardens and will have no immediate impact on neighbours.</p> <p>Gordon House, Main Road, Hillside – this application has now been approved, subject to conditions; more details required; bat survey done on 29/4.</p> <p><b>A90 Link Road proposals – Amey Consulting</b>  Cllr Duff said there is to be a briefing on 25 May 2021, which should be in the public domain soon after. Amey Consulting will put forward their findings regarding the different routes available.</p> <p>Helen queried whether or not an application had been submitted for cabins on the Stracathro estate? She had heard trees were being taken down so cabins\pods could be erected. This would be on the other side of the road near the old military base on Dun Road where permission has already been granted for 4 or 5 houses. It was suggested that we might not hear about this as it could be in the Brechin Ward.</p>	
<p><b>Correspondence</b>  All information received has been and will continue to be sent on by email.</p> <p><b>Digital training needs</b>  Davie said the platform course is still in the planning stage.</p>	
<p><b>Treasurer's report</b>  Treasurer not available.</p>
