

The Angus Council (Cairngorm Visitor Management Plan)
(Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2021

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, 4 May 2021, Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, for the likelihood of danger to the public

The Order will come into force immediately from which date it is anticipated that the work will last for a period of seven months. However, the maximum duration in terms of the Act is 18 months.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit the driving of vehicular traffic on the U405 Braedownie Road from its junction with B955 at Clova north westwards to the end of adopted section at access to Acharn a distance of 4.8km or thereby when signed by diagram 616 from The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. The prohibition will be managed by rangers on a one in one out basis

Access for pedestrians and emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

There is no alternative route
