DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES / FUNCTIONS:

To progress the local implementation of the 2018 General Medical Services (GMS) contract including developments in the following key priority areas:-

- The vaccination transformation programme.
- Pharmacotherapy services.
- Community care and treatment services.
- Urgent care (advanced practitioners).
- Additional professional roles such as musculoskeletal focused physiotherapy services.
- Community links workers (referred to in Angus as social prescribers).

With intention of creating a sustainable model of general practice through the development of an enhanced multi-disciplinary support team working in and around general practice, enabling GPs to have more capacity to fulfil their role as Expert Medical Generalists.
