CHANGES TO THE SECONDARY SCHOOL WEEK AND ANGUS EXTRA

Background

The secondary school week in Angus has been subject to debate and scrutiny at previous Children

and Learning Committees following wide-ranging consultation. It is agreed that our eight secondary

schools will move to a new timetable structure from August 2017. This will mean that secondary

schools will now deliver 33 learning periods of 50 minutes over four longer days Monday to Thursday

and one shorter day on a Friday. The parental leaflet in appendix 1 explains the changes. Our young

people and staff are still in school for the same period of time as the existing model.

Our eight secondary schools have worked together over the last few months to prepare for this

change. This includes practical elements such as the management of school to family administration

(and vice versa) and effective absence notification and monitoring. Importantly, teachers have been

preparing for curriculum opportunities that the 33 period week opens up. In conjunction with these

changes, further work has been undertaken with Dundee and Angus College to align opportunities for

our young people and we are extending the 'Angus Works' programme to offer more council-based

work experience placements. Schools continue to work with local businesses as part of the

Developing Young Workforce national policy driver to enhance the experience of our young people

and support economic development.

The timetable organisation also opens up an opportunity to provide a range of extra-curricular optional

activities on a Friday afternoon. The leaflet in appendix 2 highlights what is available for Angus young

people. A focus on physical activity aligns with our objectives to promote healthy lifestyles across

Angus. We will monitor take up of activities and evaluate further to endeavour, as far as possible, to

provide activities that our young people wish to participate.
