ANGUS COMMUNITY GRANT SCHEME

- 1.1 The Angus Council Community Grant Scheme in its most recent guise operated since 2009 and approved 581 applications. This has provided over £808,000 of support for 461 groups within the Angus community. Throughout the existence of the scheme there was a programme of continuous improvement with regards to the processes and procedures. This included targeting funding, improving the application process, creating a robust assessment and monitoring process and providing support to potential applicants. All of the applications approved or recommended for approval met the eligibility criteria of the Angus Council Community Grant Scheme.
- 1.2 The Policy and Resources Committee on 31 January 2017, (report no 42/17 refers) approved the request to move the Angus Council Community Grant Scheme budget to the Crowdfund Angus Portal to act as a match fund for community raised funds as of April 2017.
