

THE ANGUS COUNCIL (SCHOOL STREETS)(PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES)(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that on Monday, 31 May Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the purpose of introducing a pedestrian and cycles only zone.

The Order will come into force from Monday, 7 June 2021 from which date the order will last for a period of 18 months.

The Order prohibits all motor vehicles from driving on:

- Craig Crescent, Ferryden, Montrose – (8.30am – 9.30am and 2.45pm – 3.45pm)
- Taranty Road, Forfar – (8.30am – 9.15am and 2.45pm – 3.45pm)
- Taranty Place, Forfar – (8.30am – 9.15am and 2.45pm – 3.45pm)
- Timbergreen, Arbroath – (8.30am – 9.30am and 2.45pm – 3.45pm)

The prohibition of motor vehicles will be effective between the above hours, Monday to Friday, term time only.

The Order will also prohibit the waiting and loading of vehicular traffic on certain lengths of:

- Craig Road, Ferryden, Montrose,
- St Brioc Way, Ferryden, Montrose,
- Scotston of Usan Road (C45 – U476 – U478), Ferryden, Montrose
- Grampian View, Ferryden, Montrose
- Barns Brae, Ferryden, Montrose
- Taranty Road, Forfar,
- Lentlands Road, Forfar
- Lawson Avenue, Forfar
- Lawson Terrace, Forfar
- Arbirlot Road West, Arbroath
- Timbergreen, Arbroath

Access for pedestrians and emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

There are no alternative routes for vehicular traffic.
