

**THE ANGUS COUNCIL (U417 MILL OF CRUICK ROAD) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF
DRIVING AND PEDESTRIAN PASSAGE) ORDER 2021**

Notice is hereby given that on Monday, 28 June 2021, Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, for the purpose of carrying out bridge repair works.

The Order will come into force on Wednesday, 14 July 2021 from which date it is anticipated that the work will last for a period of 12 weeks. However, the maximum duration in terms of the Act is 18 months.

The Order prohibits all motorised traffic and pedestrians from taking passage on or along the **U417 Mill of Cruick Road (U416 – C30)** at Mill of Cruick Bridge; from a point 475 metres or thereby northwest of its junction with U416 West Muir – Little Brechin (U415 – C30) in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 50 metres or thereby.

The alternative route for traffic is via U417(1) Mill of Cruick Road, C30 Cortachy – Menmuir – Brechin and U416 West Muir – Little Brechin (U415 – C30).

The reverse route applies.

Pedestrian and emergency access will not be maintained.
