## 2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

The Committee agreed to note that no declarations of interest were made.

## 3. APPLICATION FOR PREMISES LICENCE REVIEW

With reference to Article 11 of the minute of meeting of this Board of 6 April 2017, there was submitted Report No LB 27/17 by the Clerk advising members of an application for a Premises Licence Review in respect of The Plough Inn, 48 Market Street, Forfar. The application was appended as Appendix 1 to the Report.

Mr Whyte was present and advised the Board that he had received the application for a premises licence review. A copy of the correspondence received from Mr Whyte was circulated to members.

Sergeant Peebles addressed the Board in support of the review application which had been submitted to the Board on 30 March 2017 from the Chief Constable, Police Scotland.

The Board asked that Sergeant Peebles report on each incident separately followed by Mr Whyte being given the opportunity to respond on the matter.

Mr Gillespie, Licensing Standards Officer then address the Board on the content of his report which was appended as Appendix 2 to the Report.

Members asked various questions and Sergeant Peebles and Mr Whyte then summed up. The Board adjourned to take legal advice and consider matters in private initially before resuming the meeting in public.

The Board concluded that it was not satisfied that a ground of review had been established and agreed that no further action be taken.
