Path running parallel with golf club has water lying on the path and drainage issues currently being resolved.

Cllr Alex King– Mostly constituent related matters. Dredging of harbour delayed as permission required to dump silt outside of the harbour itself. Water running onto path from the area of Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI), roads and parks contacted to discuss this further on Friday 04 June.
