NOTES

1. To be lodged with the Service Leader – Legal & Democratic, Angus Council, Angus House, Sylvie Way, Orchardbank Business Park, Forfar, DD8 1AN together with the appropriate lodging fee. The application will not be processed without payment of the appropriate fee.
2. Any person who in, or in connection with, the making of this application makes any statement which he knows to be false or recklessly makes any statement which is false in a material particular shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding £2,500.
3. If any condition subject to which the licence is granted is contravened or not complied with, the person(s) to whom the licence is granted shall be guilty of an offence.
4. Any person aggrieved by any condition subject to which a licence is granted may appeal when directions may be given with respect to the conditions subject to which a licence is to be granted.
5. The expression "the keeping of a breeding establishment for dogs" is, subject to certain provisions, to be construed as meaning the carrying on of a business of the breeding of dogs with a view to their being sold in the course of such breeding whether by the keeper of the business or any other person.
6. "Breeding establishment" means any premises (including a private dwelling) where any person carries on at those premises a business of breeding dogs for sale (whether by him/her or any other person).
7. Any person who keeps a breeding establishment without a licence is liable to:
 - a. imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months, or
 - b. a fine not exceeding level 4 on the standard scale, or
 - c. to both.
8. Any of the Council's officers or veterinary surgeon or any veterinary practitioner who is for the time being duly registered may, if authorised to do so by the Council in writing, enter and inspect at all reasonable times any premises in respect of which a licence has been granted and any animals found thereon, or anything therein, for the purpose of ascertaining whether an offence has been/is being committed under the Acts.
