REPORT BY ALEXANDER BERRY, CHIEF FINANCE OFFICER**

ABSTRACT

The purpose of this report is to advise of the appointment of the Chief Officer of the Integration Joint Board.

1. RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Integration Joint Board note the appointment of Gail Smith as its Chief Officer.

2. REPORT

Section 10 of the Public Bodies (Joint Working)(Scotland) Act 2014 obliges integration joint boards to appoint a Chief Officer. The Integration Joint Board, at its meeting on 29 January 2020, agreed the procedure for appointing a permanent Chief Officer (Report: IJB 2/20 refers).

Following an extensive interview process held on 8 and 16 July 2021, the appointment committee agreed to appoint Gail Smith as Chief Officer of the Angus Integration Joint Board.
