MINUTE of MEETING of the **CIVIC LICENSING COMMITTEE** held remotely on Thursday 16 September 2021 at 13.22pm.

#### 1. APOLOGIES

Apologies for absence were intimated on behalf of Councillors Boyd, Fotheringham and King.

#### 2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

The Committee agreed to note that no declarations of interest were made.

#### 3. MINUTE OF PREVIOUS MEETING

The minute of meeting of this Committee of 12 August 2021 was approved as a correct record and signed by the Convener.

#### 4. DELEGATED APPROVALS

There was submitted Report No 290/21 by the Director of Legal and Democratic Services detailing applications for licences under the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 and other miscellaneous Acts which had been granted/renewed by the Director of Legal and Democratic Services in accordance with the Scheme of Delegation appended to Standing Orders.

The Committee agreed to note the applications detailed in the Appendix to the Report, granted/renewed under delegated powers during the period 2 July 2021 to 25 August 2021.

#### 5. TAXI AND PRIVATE HIRE LICENCES – MEMBER OFFICER WORKING GROUP

With reference to Article 6 of the minute of meeting of this Committee of 12 August 2021, there was submitted Report No 291/21 by the Director of Legal and Democratic Services asking the Committee to consider establishing a Member Officer Working Group to review the licensing system and including the fees charged for taxi and private hire driver and operator licences.

The Committee agreed: -

- (i) to establish a Member Officer Working Group to review the system of licensing taxi and private hire driver and operator licences to be known as the Taxi and Private Hire Member Officer Working Group;
- (ii) that the remit of the Taxi and Private Hire Member Officer Working Group was to: -
  - (a) engage with the trade to discuss and consider concerns arising;
  - (b) assess the current processes, procedures and systems in place and including the fees charged for taxi and private hire driver and operator licences;
  - (c) identify improvements and efficiencies which would assist both the Council and the trade; and
  - (d) provide transparency in respect of the fees charged by the Council in respect of taxi and private hire driver and operator licences.
- (iii) that four members of this Committee would participate in the work of the Group; and
- (iv) that the membership of the Group be reported to the next meeting of the Civic Licensing Committee.

#### 6. EXCLUSION OF PUBLIC AND PRESS
