The Forensic & Custody Healthcare Service provide healthcare to people in police custody in Tayside and forensic medical services to collect evidence to support the prosecution of crime.

The service is responsible for carrying out forensic medical examinations on people who have experienced rape or sexual assault or, jointly with a consultant paediatrician, child sexual abuse. Healthcare needs are identified at the time of the examination and addressed as appropriate or referrals made to the relevant services.
