

THE ANGUS COUNCIL (CASTLE STREET FORFAR FOOTWAY WORKS) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING) ORDER 2022

Notice is hereby given that on 21 December 2021 Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of footway works.

The Order will come into force from 10 January 2022 from which date it is anticipated that it will last for a period of five weeks.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit the driving of vehicular traffic on the following length of road(s):

- **Castle Street (east side)** between its junctions with Queen Street and The Cross
- **Castle Street (west side)** between its junction with The Cross and Myre Road
- temporarily suspend the use of the taxi stance on the west side of Castle Street, Forfar

The alternative routes for vehicular traffic are via West High Street/Craig O'Loch Road/Queenswell Road/Castle Street or East High Street/North Street/Victoria Street/Castle Street. The reverse routes apply.
