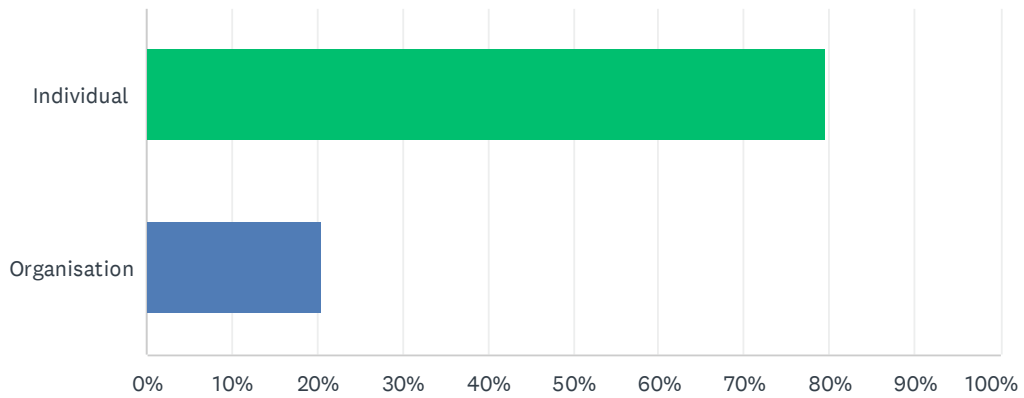


Q1 Are you responding on behalf of an organisation or individual?

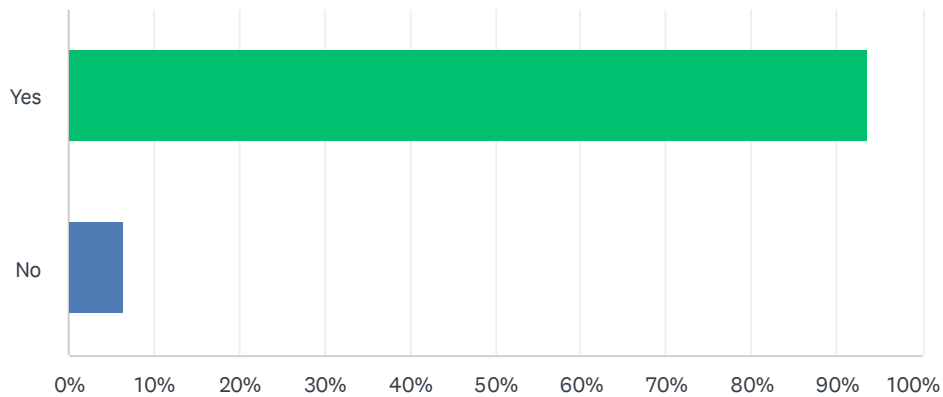

Q6 These are the actions proposed to meet the above outcomes:

Demonstrate a clear commitment to preventing antisocial behaviour, through pre-emptive actions and coordination. Tackle antisocial behaviour through early intervention by:

- o Effective policy & procedure
- o Use of legislation

Improve our response at an early stage, to reduce the number of repeat antisocial behaviour victims

Improve multiagency working to tackle antisocial behaviour and its causes. Agree defined roles & responsibilities to map out each partner's/stakeholder's function

Maximise the use of limited resources and specialist expertise to respond to changing community profiles and behavioural trends

Develop Information Sharing Agreements between services

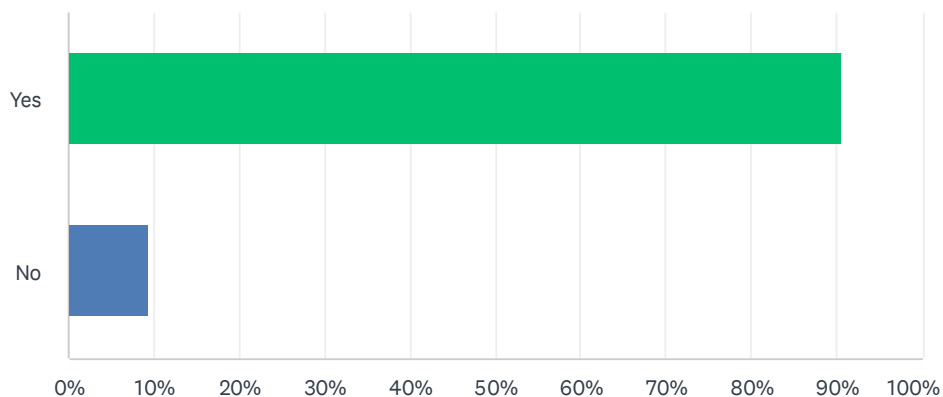
Provide training for all partners to improve awareness of who does what and when

Gather and share best practice recommendations among partners and stakeholders

Share current and relevant intelligence information in accordance with legal frameworks to both prevent and respond to antisocial behaviour. Engage communities in our work to understand and address the issues affecting local people and encourage people to lead engaged lifestyles within their local communities (public events, educational programmes). Provide awareness sessions – speak to communities to show how we are trying to help and be clear in explaining what we expect from residents. Promote mediation as an effective way of resolving neighbour disputes
