Steep stepped path has been repaired – but it has no handrail. Two benches are reinstated. Need a long length path for disability access – can carry out construction, and colourful Carnoustie.

**Problem** – need digger etc to reinstate – council says no – if the area is damaged. Funding of £1500 – many organisations have said no as it is a statutory duty of the council. Access for all physical activity, mental health and well-being, and mobility.
