More remedial work will be done in this new financial year.</p> <p><b>Cycle route from Marykirk to Montrose</b>          Cllr Duff to chase up. No money has been allocated yet.</p> <p><b>Dubton car park</b>          Cllr Duff said the Council man is not happy with what has been done and they will have to realign the rocks that have already been put down.</p> <p><b>Sunnyside Trust</b>          Shane said another meeting has been held but there is not a lot to update on. A survey will be distributed to the local area (not just Hillside). A meeting will also take place at Frockheim Community Hub to gain some inspiration!</p> <p><b>Craigo Bus</b>          No further problems noted.</p> <p><b>Community Council elections</b>          These will take place in October. If any current members wish to stand again they will need to reapply.</p> <p><b>Dog Fouling, Craigo</b>          Davie informed the meeting that he will meet with William Gilfillan, Waste Disposal manager on 23 May at 1pm to decide where to put another dog-poo bin. Anne Muir said she had already emailed Angus Council about this problem to be informed they had no funding available, so she was pleased to hear a meeting was to be held and she would also attend.</p>
