THE ANGUS COUNCIL (C37 MAIN ROAD HILLSIDE)(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2022

Notice is hereby given that on 11 July 2022 Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of insufficient road width for safe working while carrying out utility works on the carriageway

The Order will come into force from 18 July 2022 from which date it is anticipated that it will last for a period of twentytwo weeks.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit the driving of vehicular traffic on the following length of road(s):

C37 Main Road Hillside: from its junction with Hillhead of Hedderwick southeatwards to its junction with Dubton Road a distance of 1.6km or thereby. The closure will be carried out in phases with approx. dates as follows:

Section 1 – Approx. 535m– Rowanbank Cottage to Manse Road, approx. 6 weeks, Mon 18 July – Fri 26 Aug 2022.

Section 2 – Approx. 148m – Manse Road to Lamondfauld Road, approx 3 weeks, Mon 29 Aug – Fri 16 Sept 2022.

Section 3 – Approx. 230m – Lamondfauld Road to Valves at Inverarity Cres, approx. weeks, Mon 19 Sept – Fri 14 Oct 2022.

Section 4 – Approx. 212m – Inverarity Cres to War Memorial, approx. 4 weeks, Mon 17 Oct – Fri 11 Nov 2022.

Section 5 – Approx. 340m – War Memorial to Dubton Road, approx.. 5 weeks, Mon 14 Nov – Fri 16 Dec 2022

The alternative route for all of the above phases is northbound A937 Montrose to Marykirk Road, C38 Gallery Road and C37 Montrose Old Road The reverse route applies. Access for pedestrians and emergency vehicles to be maintained at all times The reverse route applies.
