**THE ANGUS COUNCIL (BURNSIDE STREET & CHARLES STREET CARNOUSTIE) (TEMPORARY  
PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2022**

Angus Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf being satisfied that traffic on the road or roads referred to in this Order should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said road or roads, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the "The Angus Council (Burnside Street & Charles Street Carnoustie) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) 2022" and shall be effective from Monday 8 August Two thousand and twenty two from which date it is anticipated that the works will last for a period of six weeks, however the maximum duration of the Act is 18 months for the purpose of a safe working area while laying a sewer on the roads referred to in Article 2 thereof.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 hereof no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to drive or be driven on in or upon the following streets in Montrose:

**Burnside Street Carnoustie** : from it junction with A930 High Street southwards for a distance of 350 metres or thereby

**Charles Street Carnoustie** : at its junction with Burnside Street both westwards and eastwards for a distance of 20m or thereby in each direction

The alternative route:

east bound is A930 Dundee Street, Camus Street and Goll Street  
westbound, A930 Dundee Street, and Brown Street.

3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in that Article if the vehicle is being used: -
  - (a) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer or drain or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus as defined in sub-paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (b) for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes or in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers and duties.
