

THE ANGUS COUNCIL (COUPAR ANGUS ROAD, NEWTYLE)(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING ORDER 2022

Notice is hereby given that on 12 September 2022 Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of the creation of passing places

The Order will come into force from 19 September 2022 from which date it is anticipated that it will last for a period of six weeks.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit the waiting of vehicular traffic in or upon either side of the following lengths of road:

- (a) Coupar Angus Road (C16): from a point 307 metres or thereby west of its junction with Muirhead – Aylth – Glenisla road (B954), extending westwards for a distance of 863 metres or thereby between 19th September and 2nd October, both dates 2022.**

The alternate route for vehicles is via Muirhead – Alyth – Glenisla road (B954), Newbigging Wood Road (U140) and Auchtertyre Road (U351). The reverse route applies.

- (b) Collace – Auchtertyre (C14): from its junction with Coupar Angus Road (C16), extending southwards then westwards for a total distance of 553 metres or thereby between 2nd October and 30th October, both dates 2022.**

The alternate route for vehicles is via is Coupar Angus Road (C16), Newton of Ballunie (C14 - C16) (U349) and Collace- Auchtertyre (C14). The reverse route applies.

The maximum duration in terms of the act is 18 months.
