Railway crossing Anderson Street

DC found out with letters from Roddy MacDougal (Railway council) - Owned by Network Rail – no footpath and land privately owned. No rights for public. 1983 – Golf links resisted its closing and needed it for vehicles. No public rights and spoke to David Thompson QC – not a public right of way. No interest in right of way for Angus Council. Other ways to cross and access the public path.

People concerned by: Public right of way – safety concerns. Precedent set – Broughty Ferry yacht club – but Golf Links do not have the right. Network Railway say it is the most dangerous crossing. Scottish government owe Network Rail. March 2020 – padlocked – and said it was shut due to covid 19? Not everyone can use alternative pathways?
