<p>Minute of 8 June 2022, proposed Helen Robertson, seconded Geoff Stranock</p> <p>Matters arising</p> <p>Flooding on Main Road, Hillside Cllr Duff said the Council will take advantage of the work being done by Scottish Water within the village (road closed etc) to look at known problem areas, as well as doing some resurfacing work. Trees are also to come down near the Scout Hall.</p> <p>Cycle route from Marykirk to Montrose Nothing further to report at the moment. The survey is still be undertaken, hoping that it will all be feasible.</p> <p>Dubton Car Park Cllr Duff to check whether the stones have been moved. Generally, there is insufficient parking in the car park, even without the lady who keeps cars there to sell.</p> <p>Sunnyside Trust Shane said there is not a lot to report from the last meeting of the Trust. A questionnaire will come out soon, to try to identify the need for the facility (community hub). It should be known next month whether or not there will be a tour of the recreation hall.</p> <p>Community Council elections These will take place in October with online applications closing on 31 August 2022. Davie, Helen and Shane have said they will apply.</p> <p>Robert Burns stone A meeting was held a few weeks and it has been agreed that the Burns memorial stone will be relocated inside Rosemount Estate, the other side of the car park gate on the right-hand side. Dave Ramsay will undersee the work necessary. The Burns Society are happy with this outcome.</p> <p>Planting a tree for Norman Braes Tony was dealing with this, so no update this evening.</p>
