

THE ANGUS COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING) (ON-STREET PARKING) (DECriminalISED ENFORCEMENT) (No. 5) ORDER 2022

On 12th September 2022 Angus Council made The Angus Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading) (On-Street Parking) (Decriminalised Enforcement) (No. 5) Order 2022. The order comes into operation on 1st October 2022.

The proposed Order was advertised in the Dundee Courier and Advertiser on 20th May 2022 and the effect of the order is as advertised in said notice.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that the Order is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from today's date, make application to the Court of Session for this purpose.
