

THE ANGUS COUNCIL (OGILVIE TERRACE, FERRYDEN, MONTROSE)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING) ORDER 2022

Notice is hereby given that on 3rd October 2022, Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 so that sewer repair works may be undertaken.

The Order will come into force on 10th October 2022 from which date it is anticipated that the work will last for a period of two weeks. However, the maximum duration in terms of the Act is 18 months.

The Order prohibits all vehicular traffic from driving or waiting on Ogilvie Terrace, Ferryden, Montrose from a point 170 metres or thereby east of its junction with Craig Road, extending eastwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby.

Access for pedestrians and emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic is via Craig Road, Ferryden to Usan to Dunninald road, Westerton Road and Usan Road. The reverse route applies.
