Minutes of meeting held in Newtyle Legion Hall
on Tuesday 7th June 2022

Approval of minutes: Approved by J Berg and seconded by D Treffry, with the amendment that was omitted from May's A.O.C.B – Are green corridors being implemented in Scotland (Green corridors being a link between two green spaces in urban areas). Cllr Bell is to investigate this.

Matters arising from minutes:

1. Paths Network – Maintenance was carried out on the Water Backie, with several children coming along to help, which is fantastic. Mike Cooper and Co. cleared more of the railway path with a strimmer last Sunday.
2. Parking in South Street – there have been notices put up re. the implementation of double yellow lines.
3. Active Travel – Angus Council are to fund more routes from the Cycling, walking and safer routes fund. There was a survey carried out and Cllr Bell mentioned the Paths Network at it. Newtyle Paths Network have applied for funding.
4. Participatory Budget Money – J Berg is still waiting for approval from Angus Council to reassign funds from the money Sustainability Newtyle received.
5. Community Survey – is still in draft form at the moment.
6. Sidlaw Paths Network – J Berg was unable to attend their meeting.
7. Litter Picking – details of this are still to follow.
8. Traffic cones at Ingliston farm – Cllr Bell to investigate this.
9. Hall Resilience – There has been a new splashback put up on the wall behind the new gas hob and draught proofing has been completed. The cupboards from the kitchen that were removed for the splashback are to be utilised in a First Aid Station within the hall.
11. Dog poo bin in Balkerrrie, Cllr Proctor still waiting on a reply.
12. Complaint: This is still being dealt with.

A.O.C.B.

1. There has been a complaint around cars parking right on the corner at the pub, this makes it difficult to see to cross over into houses in Knox Close etc. Perhaps there needs to be double yellow lines around the corner.
2. Toads, newts and frogs are getting stuck down drains – there are special ladders that can be installed in drains to help them get out. Kelly Anne Dempsey from Tayside Biodiversity can assist with advice on this. Please can we ask that that you do not put any toxic substances down the drains. There is also still the problem of birds making a mess – please do not feed them. There is a portal on Angus Council website for reporting bird problems.
3. Wall at park – the wall from the car park into the park has been damaged, Angus Council are saying its not their responsibility as the car park does not belong to them. D Treffry is trying to contact Nigel Cayzer re. this matter.
4. Toilets in the park – P Small has liaised with the people who look after the park, hopefully going forward the toilets will be open at the weekends.
