

THE ANGUS COUNCIL (LOWSON AVENUE & LOWSON TERRACE, FORFAR)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING) ORDER 2022

Notice is hereby given that on 19<sup>th</sup> December 2022, Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 so that footway repair works may be undertaken.

The Order will come into force on 9<sup>th</sup> January 2023 from which date it is anticipated that the work will last for a period of four weeks. However, the maximum duration in terms of the Act is 18 months.

The Order prohibits all vehicular traffic from driving and waiting daily between 8.00am and 3.00pm on or in the following roads:

- (1) Lawson Avenue, Forfar between its junctions with A94 Glamis Road and Taranty Road, including culs-de sac.
- (2) Lawson Terrace, Forfar over its entire length.

Access for pedestrians and emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic is via A94 Galmis Road, A926 Dundee Loan, A926 Dundee Road, lentlands Road and Taranty Road. The reverse route applies.
