# Police Update.

# **Councillors Update.**

There will be a full Angus Council meeting later this week to discuss the budget and it is expected that difficult decisions will have to be made regarding service cuts and charges for some council services. There are some concerns about the length of time taken to change tenants when a Council house comes empty with the resulting loss of revenue. There have been problems with contractors carrying out repairs.

Angus Alive is suffering from staffing and energy cost problems leaving leisure and culture services in doubt. Being a charity Angus Alive saves Angus Council about £1.5 million a year.
