## THE ANGUS COUNCIL (PANMURE STREET, MONIFIETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING) ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that on Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2023, Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 so that public utility connection works may be undertaken.

The Order will come into force on Monday, 30<sup>th</sup> January 2023 from which date it is anticipated that the work will last for a period of seven weeks. However, the maximum duration in terms of the Act is 18 months.

The effect of this Order insofar as it relates to:

## Prohibition of Waiting 30 January – 26 February 2023

Panmure Road. Monifieth (A930) (southside) from its junction with Well Street north eastwards for a distance of 100m or thereby

## **Prohibition of Driving 27 February - 19 March 2023**

Panmure Road. Monifieth (A930) from its junction with Well Street north eastwards for a distance of 100m or thereby

Access for pedestrians and emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic is via Panmure Street (A930), High Street (A930), Maule Street (A930), Ferry Road (A930), Grange Road, West Grange Road, Dundee – Arbroath (A92), Monifieth – Templehall (B962), Panmure Street (B962/A930).

The reverse route applies.
