

THE ANGUS COUNCIL (SOUTH ESK ROAD, TANNADICE, FORFAR)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING) ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that on 16th January 2023, Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 so that sewer repair works may be undertaken.

The Order will come into force on Tuesday, 24th January 2023 from which date it is anticipated that the work will last for a period of nine days. However, the maximum duration in terms of the Act is 18 months.

The Order prohibits all vehicular traffic from driving on South Esk Road, Tannadice, Forfar (B957) extending from its junction with Manse Lane in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 60 metres or thereby.

Access for pedestrians and emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic is via Tannadice to Finavon (B957), Dundee to Aberdeen (A90)(T), Forfar to Kirriemuir (A926), Kirriemuir to Glamis (A928), High Street, Kirriemuir (B956), Kirriemuir to Tannadice (B957). The reverse route applies.
