Notice is hereby given that on 13 February 2023 Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of insufficient road width for safe working for utility works, on the carriageway

The Order will come into force from 22 February 2023 from which date it is anticipated that it will last for a period of Seven weeks.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit the driving and waiting of vehicular traffic on the following length of road(s):

Prohibition of Waiting & Loading From 22-28 February 2023

James Street Carnoustie : Cul-de-sac: both sides of the carriageway. From a point 40m or thereby south of its junction with Gibson Street westwards for a distance of 40m

From 28 February – 7th April 2023

Taymouth Terrace Carnoustie (both sides): from its junction with Anderson Street westwards for a distance of 40m or thereby.

Malt Loan Carnoustie (both sides): from its junction with Anderson Street eastwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby.

Anderson Street Carnoustie (both sides): from its junction with Taymouth Terrace northwards for a distance of 27m or thereby

Anderson Street Carnoustie (both sides): from its junction with Taymouth Terrace southwards for a distance of 18m or thereby.

Prohibition of Driving From 28 February – 7 April 2023

Taymouth Terrace from its junction with Anderson Street westwards for a distance of 40m or thereby

The alternative route westbound is Anderson Street, Thomas Street, James Street. The reverse route applies

Pedestrian and emergency access will be maintained
