

THE ANGUS COUNCIL (WELLBRAEHEAD FORFAR)(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING) ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that on 27 February 2023 Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of carriageway resurfacing.

The Order will come into force from 10 March 2023 from which date it is anticipated that it will last for a period of 10 days.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit the driving of vehicular traffic on the following length of road(s):

- Green Street, Forfar : from its junction with Queen Street, northwards for its entire length.
- There is suspended the one-way traffic restriction on the entire length of Wellbraehead, Forfar as provided by Article 9 of Part II of the Schedule to Angus Council (Forfar Traffic Management) Order 2009, for the duration of the works.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic southbound is Wellbraehead, North Street (B9120), East High Street Green Street. The Alternative route for northbound is Queen Street, east High Street, North Street (B9120), Wellbraehead.

Throughout the duration of the works there is hereby suspended, under Article 21 of the Angus Council (Off-Street Car Parks)(Decriminalised Enforcement) Order 2017, East Green car park, Forfar, the suspension of the disabled bay (DB0307) and electric vehicle charging bay (EB0056).
