2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST/STATEMENTS OF TRANSPARENCY

There was submitted Report No 87/23 by the Service Leader – Planning and Sustainable Growth detailing application No. 22/00801/FULL by Monifieth Community Resource Group for the erection of a building to accommodate Monifieth Community Hub and Library which would include a reception, activity hall, cafe, kitchen, gym space, library, toilets and changing areas with associated support parking and external hard and soft landscaping on land at Riverview Drive, Monifieth. The application was recommended for approval subject to conditions.

Slides were shown following which Mr Watson, an objector, and Mr Robertson and Mr Williams, on behalf of the Monifieth Community Resource Group addressed the meeting and answered members' questions.
