Welcome and introductions

#### Police Report

The report received was for the time period 7<sup>th</sup> December – 8<sup>th</sup> February and the following was reported:

36 calls received in respect of Tealing and surrounding area in this assessment period

Crimes of violence/Threats - 1 recorded crime

Crimes of Dishonesty - 1 recorded crime

Miscellaneous/ other crimes including Threatening & Abusive Behaviours, assaults and other offences against emergency workers – 1 recorded crime

Calls to Police and recorded crime remain at low levels for the Tealing area. The majority of calls to Police for the area are in respect of the A90 for Road traffic matters.

Cuppa with a Copper – possibility of arranging in the future.

#### Angus Councillors Report

Cllr. Melville emailed his report:

Over the last few weeks I've been busy alongside my colleagues supporting constituents. The bulk of contacts from constituents over recent weeks have been transport, housing and energy related.

Our relentless focus as an Administration has been allocating whatever resource we can to support families and households on the lowest incomes. We recently had a report go to the Council's Scrutiny and Audit committee which highlighted how our Cost of Living Support Fund has helped families across Angus. I would encourage anyone interested to have a look. Work is also well progressed on the Administration's first Budget. These really are some of the most turbulent economic times we've ever faced, and our Budget will seek to navigate a way through that, while enshrining the progressive values and support for the most vulnerable that are central to our mission.

Cllr. Whiteside reported:

- the budget meeting will be held on 2<sup>nd</sup> March
- there is a Help for the Cost of Living page on the Angus Council website <u>Help with the cost of living |</u> <u>Angus Council</u>
- Angus Council have a bus ticket scheme that helps people with the cost of travel in certain circumstances

#### **Resident Issues**

Following the Tealing Community Consultation the following issues have been highlighted as being of concern to many local residents and have been highlighted to Cllr. Whiteside to feedback to Angus Council:

- 1. A90 safety and crossing improvements
- 2. Better and more frequent public transport
- 3. Visiting health and drop-in public services
- 4. Improved street lighting
- 5. Traffic calming throughout the village
- 6. Improved broadband and connectivity

Arcadis – Angus Active Travel Routes feasibility study – School Road, Tealing – responses to be submitted by 16<sup>th</sup> March.

20mph speed limits – no feedback as of yet from the initiative.

The 40mph-20mph near School Road and the 40mph speed limit not being adhered to on Emmock Road – raised as a concern to Cllr. Whiteside.

Bird scarers - Cllr. Whiteside to check the rules in place regarding times and frequencies

SSEN update – water tanks to be delivered to site via concrete wagons on Friday 10<sup>th</sup>.

Bus service – buses not stopping etc – Cllr. Whiteside to advise who to contact.

Park & Ride – Shuttle buses – due to the implementation of low emission zones in Dundee – this is an ongoing issue as sites are being looked at.

Cllr. Whiteside left the meeting at 19:20.
