

TRAFFIC ORDER

THE ANGUS COUNCIL (B955 KIRRIEMUIR TO FORTER)(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING) ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that on 29 May 2023, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Angus Council made The Angus Council (B955 Kirriemuir to Forter)(Temporary Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) Order 2023 and shall be effective from 5th June 2023 from which it is anticipated that the works will last for a period of three weeks, however the maximum duration of the Act is 18 months for the purpose of the carriageway resurfacing/patching works

The effect of the order is to:

B951 Kirriemuir - Glenisla – Glenshee road between its junctions with Slade Road (B955) Kirriemuir to A93 Blairgowrie to Glenshee Road.

The affected roads above will not be restricted for the full time period stated. The closure will be implemented in a phased manor as below :

Phase 1- B951 to B954

The alternative route for phase1 is A926 Blairgowrie - Kirriemuir – Forfar and B954 Muirhead - Alyth – Glenisla road

Phase 2 – B951 to A93

The alternative route for phase 2 is B954 Muirhead - Alyth – Glenisla road, A926 Blairgowrie - Kirriemuir – Forfar, A93 Blairgowrie to Glenshee Road

The reverse route for both phases above applies. Access for pedestrians and emergency vehicles to be maintained at all times
