1. Community Survey: no date has been set for an open day

2. Participatory Budget: being transferred from Sustainability

Great news on this, we finally got the data gathered over

data confirmed that over 80% of drivers were speeding	
through the village. Angus Council are proposing to

Coupar Angus Road in Muirhead, this will hopefully slow	
down drivers as they enter the village. An order for double	
yellow lines at the pub corner has gone through, just	
waiting on this to be implemented.
