Notice is hereby given that on 19 June 2023 Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of insufficient road width for gas network connections, on the carriageway

The Order will come into force from 26 June 2023 from which date it is anticipated that it will last for a period of six weeks.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit the driving and waiting of vehicular traffic on the following length of road(s):

Prohibition of Waiting & Loading

- **George Street, Montrose** (west side): from its junction with South Esk Street south eastwards for a distance of 25m or thereby.
- **George Street, Montrose** (east side): from its junction with Baltic Street north westwards for a distance of 25m or thereby
- **South Esk Street Montrose** (North west side): from its junction with George Street south west wards for a distance for a distance of 25 metres or thereby.

Prohibition of Driving

• **Bow Butts Montrose** from its junction with Panmure Place for its entire length;

The alternative route is:

Westbound is Panmure Place and George Street, Eastbound is Panmure Place, Museum Street and Baltic Street.
