APPOINTMENTS

REPORT BY GAIL SMITH, CHIEF OFFICER

ABSTRACT

The purpose of this report is to extend the current arrangements in place and to also designate a new Depute Chief Officer from 1 August 2023.

1. RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the Integration Joint Board:-

- (i) agrees to designate Jillian Galloway, Head of Community Health and Care Services, as Depute Chief Officer for a further period until 31 July 2023 in order to support operational demand; and
- (ii) agrees to designate Eunice McLennan, Head of Community Health and Care Services, as Depute Chief Officer from 1 August 2023 until the IJB in February 2024.

2. BACKGROUND

Section 6 of the Integration Scheme between Angus Council and NHS Tayside provides:-

“The Parties jointly agree that a member of the senior team of direct reports who is an employee of either the Council or NHS Tayside will be designated as the Depute Chief Officer. This Depute Chief Officer will carry out the functions of the Chief Officer if/when the Chief Officer is absent or otherwise unable to carry out their functions for a period exceeding two weeks”.

3. CURRENT POSITION

With reference to Article 5 of the minute of meeting of 26 April 2023, the IJB agreed the request to designate Jillian Galloway, Head of Community Health and Care Services, Depute Chief Officer for a further period of two months to support operational demand.

4. PROPOSAL

It is recommended that the IJB agrees to further extend the designation of Jillian Galloway, Head of Community Health and Care Services as Depute Chief Officer until 31 July 2023 in order to support operational demand. Thereafter agree to designate Eunice McLennan, Head of Community Health and Care Services as Depute Chief Officer from 1 August 2023 until the IJB in February 2024.
