Statement of Reasons

for proposing to make Angus Council (Disabled Persons' Parking Places) (Off-Street Parking Places) (Decriminalised Enforcement) (Variation) Order 202x

In order to promote the proper use of disabled parking places and in order to comply with the requirements of the Disabled Persons' Parking Places (Scotland) Act 2009. Angus Council propose to make an Order in order to:-

1. make it an offence for anyone to park in any of the marked and signed off-street disabled persons parking places, shown detailed below in Part 1 of the schedule below, unless they hold a valid blue badge used in accordance with the terms of the national blue badge legislation; and
2. remove existing marked and signed off-street disabled parking places, shown detailed below in Part 2 of the schedule below, provided at the request of local residents who met the necessary criteria but for various reasons are no longer required.

ARBROATH.

- parking area off Bloomfield Road, parking area off Lamb Terrace, parking area off Clancy's Way court off parking area off Mayfield Terrace.

BRECHIN

- parking area of Drumachlie Park

CARNOUSTIE.

- off street parking places Admiral Street;

FORFAR.

- parking court off Lordburn Place, parking area of Arbroath Road;

KIRRIEMUIR.

- parking area off Prosen Road; parking area off Hillrise

MONIFIETH.

- parking area off Brook Street;

MONTROSE.

- Parking areas off Caledonian Place
