Notice is hereby given that on Monday, 28 August 2023, Angus Council made an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, for the purpose of the construction of civil engineering works

The Order will come into force on Monday 4 September 2023 from which date it is anticipated that the work will last for a period of five weeks. However, the maximum duration in terms of the Act is 18 months.

The Order prohibits all pedestrians from taking passage on or along the NCN1 footpath/cycle way at Barry Station, Station Road, Barry, westwards for a distance of 490m

The alternative route for pedestrians/cyclists eastbound is Station Road Barry, footpath between Station Road and McDonaldsmith Drive, Ravensby Road, Thomas Street, Victoria Street, Kinloch Street, Links Avenue Links Parade, Nation Cycle Route One. The reverse route applies..

No person shall cause or permit the waiting and loading of vehicular traffic on the following length of road(s)

• **STATION ROAD**, **BARRY**(Bothsides) : from a point 632m or thereby from its junction with A930 Dundee to Muridrum Road, southwards for a distance on 200m or thereby.
