The police report was as follows:

Assessment period – 29/03/2023 – 06/06/2023

There were 14 calls received in respect of Tealing and surrounding area in this assessment period.

There were 4 crimes recorded in respect of your area over this assessment period –
Group 1 – Crimes of violence/Threats – 1 recorded crime.
Group 2 – Crimes of sexual nature – 0
Group 3 – Crimes of Dishonesty – 2 recorded crimes.
Group 4 – Crimes involving property damage – 0
Group 5 & 6 – Miscellaneous/ other crimes including Threatening & Abusive Behaviours, assaults and other offences against emergency workers – 1 recorded crime.
Group 7 – Road traffic crimes – 0

Further information.

Angus has seen a rise in vehicle crime where perpetrators target unlocked vehicles with intention of stealing them or stealing from them. We have previously seen occasions where perpetrators have also entered unlocked houses and stolen vehicle keys. We would encourage residents to keep their vehicles and properties secure and continue to report any suspicious activity to us.

We are strongly encouraging residents to sign up to ‘Neighbourhood Watch Scotland’ the details of the scheme are above. This allows residents to be notified via email of local crime trends, guidance and advice.

We have also obtained a stock of no cold calling door stickers from Trading Standards that we will distribute in the local area.

In addition to the above we have recently attended at Tealing Primary School and carried out an Online Safety, Social Media and Mobile phone presentation to the P5 – P7 classes, this was well received by pupils and staff.

Angus Councillors Report

There has been a proposal to Angus Council to extend the consultation for SSEN.
Graeme Day’s surgery is to be held on Friday in Tealing Hall - TCC to promote this to the community and advise individuals to contact directly to make an appointment.
Active Travel Feasibility Study - Cllr. Whiteside was made aware of the resident who was not happy at not being informed directly regarding the study.
Speed limit through Tealing at the bottom of School Road - request for change from 40mph to 20mph.
School Bus - work in progress. Routes to be looked at and planned accordingly.
