<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. School Friendly Zone – Angus Council are proposing a trial for a school friendly zone to encourage children to walk to school. Markers for this are emissions, traffic volume, traffic congestion and accidents. This will be implemented with the start of the new school term in August and

<p>trial will run for 18 months. Streets affected will be Dunarn Street, Dunarn Terrace and Old School Court, where there will be traffic restrictions at certain times in the morning and afternoon to all traffic apart from residents (who can apply for a permit), carers, utility vehicles and delivery drivers.</p>	
<p>Mr Stirton has come along as a representative of the residents in these streets. They believe that none of the markers given apply to this area, most of the children currently walk to school, with the remainder that do get dropped off by cars do so via the school entrance on the Dundee Road. Mr Stirton conducted a survey of vehicles on Dunarn Street over three days during what will be the restricted times, results are as follows:</p>	
<p>Day 1 – Morning 4 vehicles Afternoon 7 vehicles</p>	
<p>Day 2 – Morning 4 vehicles Afternoon 5 vehicles</p>	
<p>Day 3 – Morning 2 vehicles Afternoon 5 vehicles</p>	
<p>Most of these vehicles were residents and there were also delivery vehicles included in the figures.</p>	
<p>There is to be another Stakeholders meeting held before the start date of the trial and Mr Stirton has asked to be invited to the meeting as the residents rep. Cllr Bell will enquire if this is possible. We have also asked if we can get air quality data.</p>	<p>Cllr Bell</p>
